1494	Sir William is appointed a Justice of the Peace for Berkshire.		

Lordship of Bullocks

Date	History of Lordship	Monarchs
1502/4	Sir William gives legal advice to King Henry and is rewarded with custodian and stewardship of several Royal manors and the Hundred of Chadlington in Oxfordshire.	
1505	Sir William becomes Steward to the Chancellor of Oxford University,	
1507	Sir William bequeaths Bullocks to his son William with the remainder (estate after death) to Lionel and Richard his other sons.	
Unknown	William dies and Bullocks passes to Sir Lionel.	
1534	The Act of Supremacy – Church of England	Henry VIII 1509-47
1536	Sir Lionel dies childless and Bullocks passes to John Norreys of Fyfield. John serves as a gentleman usher in the royal household.	
1548	John settles (conveys) Bullocks on his son William.	Edward VI 1547-53
1553	William is a Gentleman Usher to the Privy Chamber.	Mary I 1553-58
1555	William serves as a Member of Parliament.	
1567	William is Controller of Works for Windsor Castle and keeper of Foliejon Park, Berkshire.	Elizabeth I 1558-1603
1577	John dies leaving his son and heir William, who is now gentleman usher to Black Rod at Parliament.	
1591	William dies leaving a son and heir Sir John.	
1606	Sir John settles Bullocks on himself for life with the remainder to his sister-in-law Elizabeth and her husband Thomas, Lord Erskine in tail (including his heirs). The Manor and Lordship of Bullocks is not recorded again.	James I 1603-25
